FY 2010 SCHOOL AID ALLOWABLE GROWTH RATE BILL

Allowable Growth Rate

The House passed HF 2140 (School Aid Allowable Growth Rate Bill) on February 6. The Senate passed HF 2140 on February 7. Without amendment, the Bill now goes to the Governor. The Bill requires that the FY 2010 State cost per pupil increase by 4.0% over the FY 2009 State cost per pupil. The result will increase each school district's cost per pupil by \$222 and establish the FY 2010 State cost per pupil at \$5,768.

Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact of HF 2140 will be an estimated total cost of \$2.349 billion to the State General Fund. The overall impact of HF 2140 is provided in the following table:

ICN

The Iowa Communications Network (ICN) reported to the Iowa Telecommunications and Technology Commission (ITTC) the results of the 2007 ICN Savings Report. For calendar year 2007, the ICN reported a total savings of \$14.8 million from 18 State agencies. A total of 1,984 video conference sessions were utilized that allowed 178,773 people to participate in ICN video sessions.
