Joint Field Office Opens in West Des Moines

The Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division (HSEMD) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) have established a Joint Field Office (JFO) in West Des Moines in response to the winter storms that occurred Dec. 23-27, 2009, and Jan. 19-26, 2010.

The JFO officially opened on Monday. FEMA and HSEMD staff will work to distribute funds to state and local governments as well as certain nonprofit organizations, including rural electric cooperatives and municipal utilities in 21 counties for the December storms and 12

counties for the January storms.

The Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) is a capabilities and performance-based exercise program that provides a standardized methodology and terminology for exercise design, development, conduct, evaluation and improvement planning. HSEEP constitutes a national standard for all exercises.

This course is based on one important premise: Emergency exercises are worth the effort. Exercises identify areas that are proficient and those that need improvement. Lessons learned from exercises can be used to revise operational plans and provide a basis for training to improve proficiency in executing those plans.

This course is designed to introduce participants to the fundamentals of exercise design and to prepare them to design and conduct a small functional exercise for their organization.
